- 1. Lights must be visible from the road.
- 2. Light displays must be lit during contest dates and times: 5pm-8pm 12/3, 12/4, 12/5, 12/10, 12/11, and 12/12. You are encouraged to light them up more frequently for people who may be driving around on other dates.
- 3. Displays may consist of any holiday, religious, or winter themes.
- 4. All entries must be located in Upton.
- 5. Businesses and residential addresses are allowed to participate.
- 6. By entering this contest, you are agreeing to have your address published in correlation with this contest. This will include the map, but may also include advertising for the purpose of this contest. The winner will also be announced on our website and social media platforms.
- 7. By entering in this contest, you agree and acknowledge that the Town of Upton, Upton Recreation Commission, and all its agents and volunteers are fully harmless for any and all losses that you may incur as a result of participating in this contest.
- 8. Entries are due by 8pm November 29th.
- 9. Judging will be done by the public. There is no residency requirement for judging. Judging will be based on a score of 1-10 and the scores will be averaged. An entry must have a minimum of 5 votes to be eligible to win.
