



Upton Rec's 11th Annual Recyclable Boat Race Wed. August 8th, 6pm.

Rules

All boats must register PRIOR to racing.

All boats must be to the beach by 5: 15 and pass judges inspection prior to the race.

Captain and crew must be IN the boat when it crosses the finish line.

Use of paddles is acceptable (either store bought or made from recyclable materials).

Human powered only (No motors or engines).

All boats must be removed from water and disassembled by the end of the race. It is the responsibility of the crew members to appropriately recycle their materials.

All crew members must wear Coast guard approved flotation devices and foot protection.

All registered boats must be named.

Construction Rules

Any form of paddle is permitted.

All materials must be recyclable.

Use of rope/string is permissible.

Use of duct tape or packing tape ON SEAMS ONLY is permitted.

NO Styrofoam or metal allowed.

Only water based paint is allowed.
